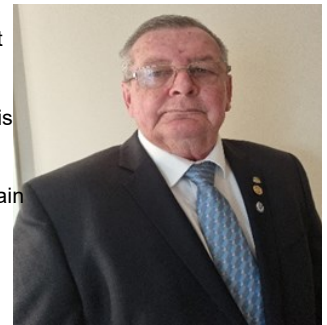

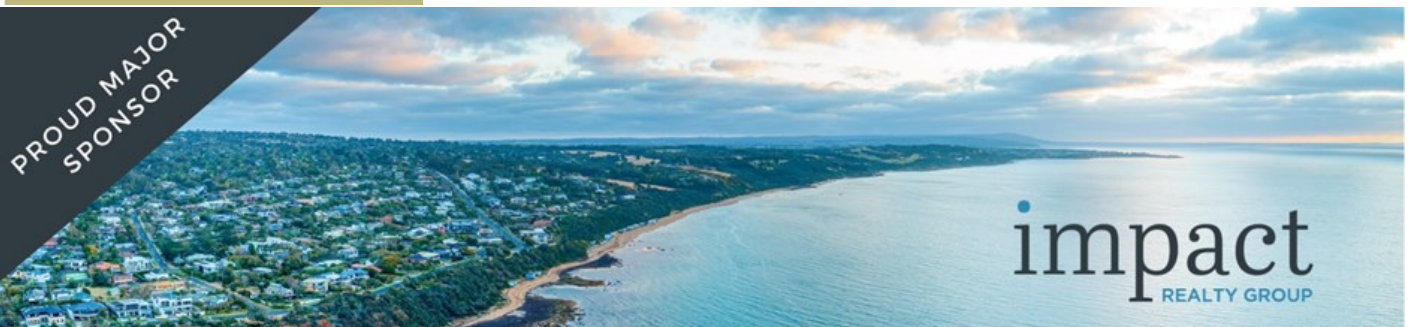
This week will be a fun night with Chairman Glenn Ellam hosting our Football Finals Night it promises to be good fun all round. Do not forget to wear you Footy colours.

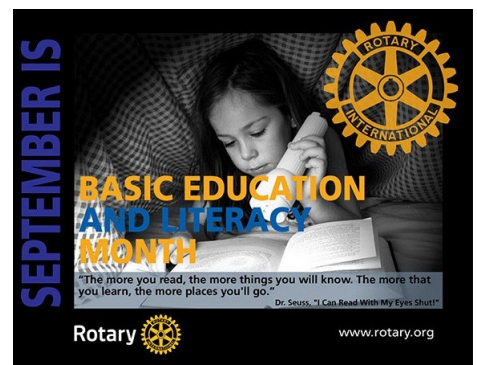
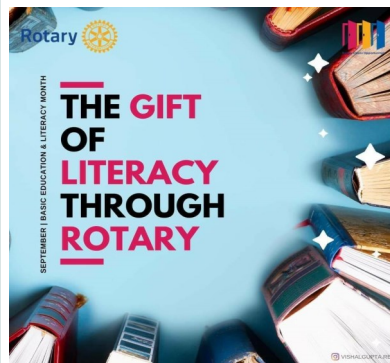

Highlights of Speaker address:

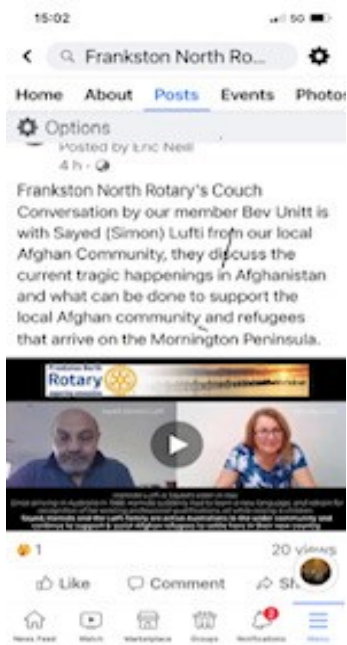
It was a club assembly night with healthy discussion around what activities the club can do in this Covid time to support our community. A few ideas were to be put to the board meeting following the club assembly.
