

Rebecca Olver has worked in social work and community development for over 30 years.

From volunteering for youth work, family reconciliation, chaplaincy, case management to senior roles in not for profit organisations, Rebecca has always carried a passion and drive to inspire many individuals and families to have hope and make positive life changing decisions.

Rebecca left management to pursue The Local four years ago, she is currently also working as a trainer in cert 4 and diplomas in mental health and community services

Rebecca is a mum of 3 adult children: Jessica aged 33 and a mum of 2 young boys, Nicholas is 31 and a social worker and Luke is 25 and in the Navy.

The Local2Community is located in a small shopping strip in Frankston North and an Op Shop providing cheap used clothing and food to underprivileged people in the immediate area. It also provides counselling and mentoring to those doing it tough. It is a happy non-judgmental open environment, staffed by volunteers that offers free food, advice, a meeting place and moral support to people in need. Our Club has worked in a cleanup of the backyard and is looking at other opportunities to assist in the work of this important community service organisation.


