



Guest Speaker: - DG Linda Humphries



Linda reminded us that Rotary International has nominated Mental Health as a major area of focus this year and it is pleasing that Frankston North Club is also concentrating on Mental Health this year.

It is a fact that being in Rotary is actually good for keeping mentally healthy. The supportive fellowship and the knowledge that you are doing good work in the community is good for your own mental health. Australia is at the forefront in Mental Health through Australia Rotary Health's excellent programs. Rotary also includes promoting World Peace and empowering girls among it's areas of Focus.

On the subject of the upcoming merger of Districts 9810 and 9820 into the new District 9815, it is progressingwell. The new Constitution has been completed and administration issues are being addressed. The new District will provide a bigger pool of talent with 81 Clubs available to draw on, and hopes to lower the cost of being a Rotarian.

The Zone Regionalisation will give Australia a greater voice in Rotary affairs and will cut out a lot of duplication through Rotary globally. Clubs will have more options in our part of the world. There is a Zone 8 on-line Conference on 28/29 October. See the District webpage for details.

The upcoming District 9820 Conference in Warrnambool next year requires club contribution regarding our past local and international projects. Photos and information for a presentation to be played at the Conference. Completion date 31st October.

District Foundation Chairman <u>Mark Humphries</u> presented Maree with a certificate to our Club for being a Club Annual Donor - Level 1, 2022 acknowledging our donation of \$US128,594 over 5 years.

The Rotary Foundation Polio Plus program is still fighting to rid the world of polio. At last count their were 5 cases in Afghanistan and 1 in Pakistan. While we are nearly there, eradicating polio in these countries is extremely difficult and if it is not totally eliminated it could spread into other countries and years of Rotary's work could be undone. To achieve this ultimate goal we must push harder. We are asking for a minimum donation of \$100 per head to complete this challenge through the Centurion Program or by direct donation to Polio Plus. We thank you for the tremendous support you have shown over the years, but we still need donations to wipe out the last remnants of polio in the world.
