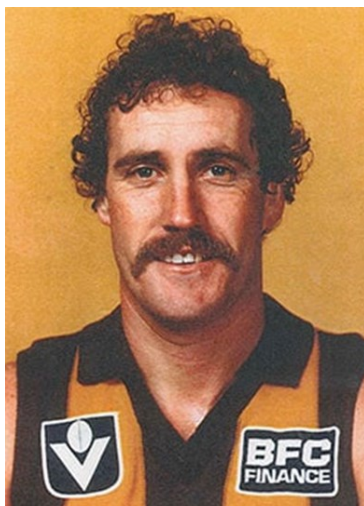

He played in 13 interstate games for the big V, Hawthorn Hall of Fame and Life member of AFL. We conducted a Q and A discussion with Kelvin covering juniors to seniors, how he got there, the best players, reviewed the 3 Grand Finals he played in and had many questions from the floor. We asked Kelvin who he thinks will win on Saturday and he is leaning towards the Brisbane Lions. A super session and great responses, Kelvin, thanks for sharing with us.
