We received a note from Sandi Fulcher, the local coordinator of the Trachoma Project we have been supporting.

Racheal (the contact on site) says not all boxes are in Ampilatwatja as they have to travel by car, 400kms of dirt road.

So far they have received 4 boxes and handed out one pack to a young family where the smile on the mother's face being given some deodorant was just amazing. This family are living in a 3 bedroom home with 25 people and it does not have any hot water. Rachael found a tap outside the house so was able to show the family how to use the face washer and the other items in the kits. She has two children with the youngest being 6 months old. Her partner and father of the child cannot read the Hygiene card but Rachael hopes the pictures will help explain the hygiene steps as well as Rachael taking them through the items.

I think from our discussion, that Rachael will be personally handing the kits to each family and taking them through the kits which is amazing. That 56 times she will be doing so. I was expecting a group information session. This is so much better.

It sounds to me that you have been connected with the perfect community where Rotary can make a difference beyond trachoma if you want. And Rachael has every intention of maximising the connection. As she said, you are enabling her to do her job.

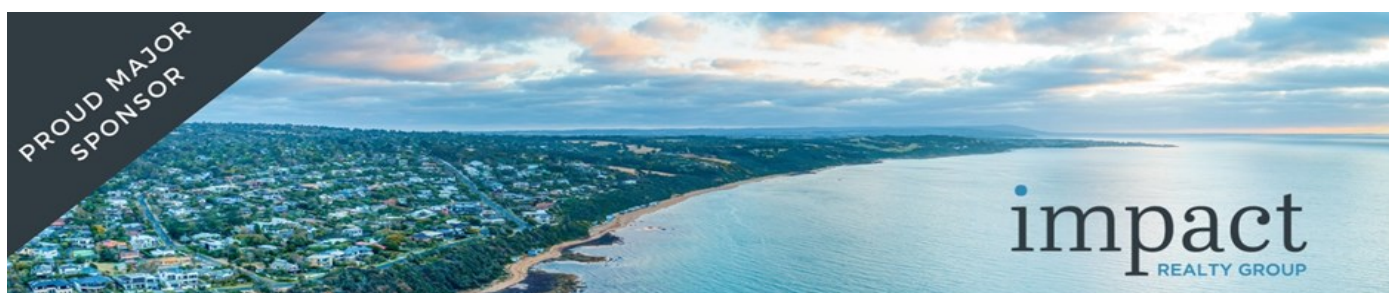
